Be Safe, Be Responsible, Be Respectful, Be Ready to Learn

Observe the problem behavior, state the expectation, and decide if it is a minor or major behavior.

MINOR

(Teacher Managed)

Encourage/Redirect

Use natural consequences.

Proposed Step System

- 1. Non-verbal reminder
- 2. Verbal reminder/conference
 - Re-teach four agreements
- 3. Mindful Minutes in classroom
- 4. Buddy classroom
 - Reflection Sheet
 - Email home & cc Admin/ secretary

When 2 reflection sheets have been completed, remind student/family that next step is office referral.

Office Referral

Complete office referral upon completion of 3 reflection sheets.

Minor Examples

Classroom disruptions

Refusal to follow reasonable directions

Failure to follow school rules

Plagiarism/Cheating/Forgery/Lying

Refusal to do work

Inappropriate comments/put downs

Inappropriate use of technology

Misuse of school property (including playground equipment)

Horseplay or roughhousing

Running in hallway

Major Examples

Fighting/Assault

Alcohol/Tobacco/Drugs

Bullying/Harassment/Intimidation

Defiance (major disruptive outbursts)

Endangerment

Gambling/Selling

Racial slurs/Offensive gestures

Foul language at staff

Leaving school grounds

Sexual misconduct

Theft

Vandalism/Property damage

Weapons

Threat (towards others, self, or property)

MAJOR

(Admin Managed)

Immediate Office Referral

Send referral to admin. If threat is immediate, call secretary and send/escort student to office.

Proposed Step System (Admin Only)

- 1. Witness Conference (s)
- 2. Student Conference
- 3. Consequence Given
- 4. Parent/Guardian Contact
- 5. PS Log Entry
- 6. Email grade level team/specials
