*Dear Sacred Heart School Families and Friends,*

As a parish, Sacred Heart had a good year. We had another year of roughly 10% increase in weekend mass attendance. The school also continues to thrive. This doesn't happen by accident. I want to thank the staff at the parish and school for their dedication and professionalism. But, more, important, I appreciate the way that for them this isn't merely a job. There is a spirit of true ministry in the day-to-day working of the staff.

In last year's Annual Report Letter, I mentioned that I was one year in as Pastor at Sacred Heart and was waiting to see what would be happening to our parish as we moved forward with Partners in the Gospel. Well, now we know. In fact, Sacred Heart and St. Monica on Mercer Island, have become one family and we're starting to imagine the future with that in mind.

The future is known to God alone but given my limited human foresight I foresee both the Sacred Heart and the St. Monica campuses and schools remaining open as our Family grows together. But there have already been ways in which we have begun sharing faith. Sacred Heart and St. Monica now have a common RCIA/OCIA program. We share a marriage prep program and wedding coordinators. While both churches are available for individual baptisms, we will have a common baptismal prep class before too long. Our new high school youth minister was hired – not for either St. Monica or Sacred Heart – but for the Family as a whole. She will minister at both campuses. All future hires will be made with a similar vision. And there will be more melding of communities to come.

I know I speak for Fr. Joseph, as well, when I thank you, the parishioners of Sacred Heart, for your trust and openness to us and the vision of Partnership in the Gospel. May the Holy Spirit continue to bless us with patience and faith as we serve Jesus and His Church together at Sacred Heart.

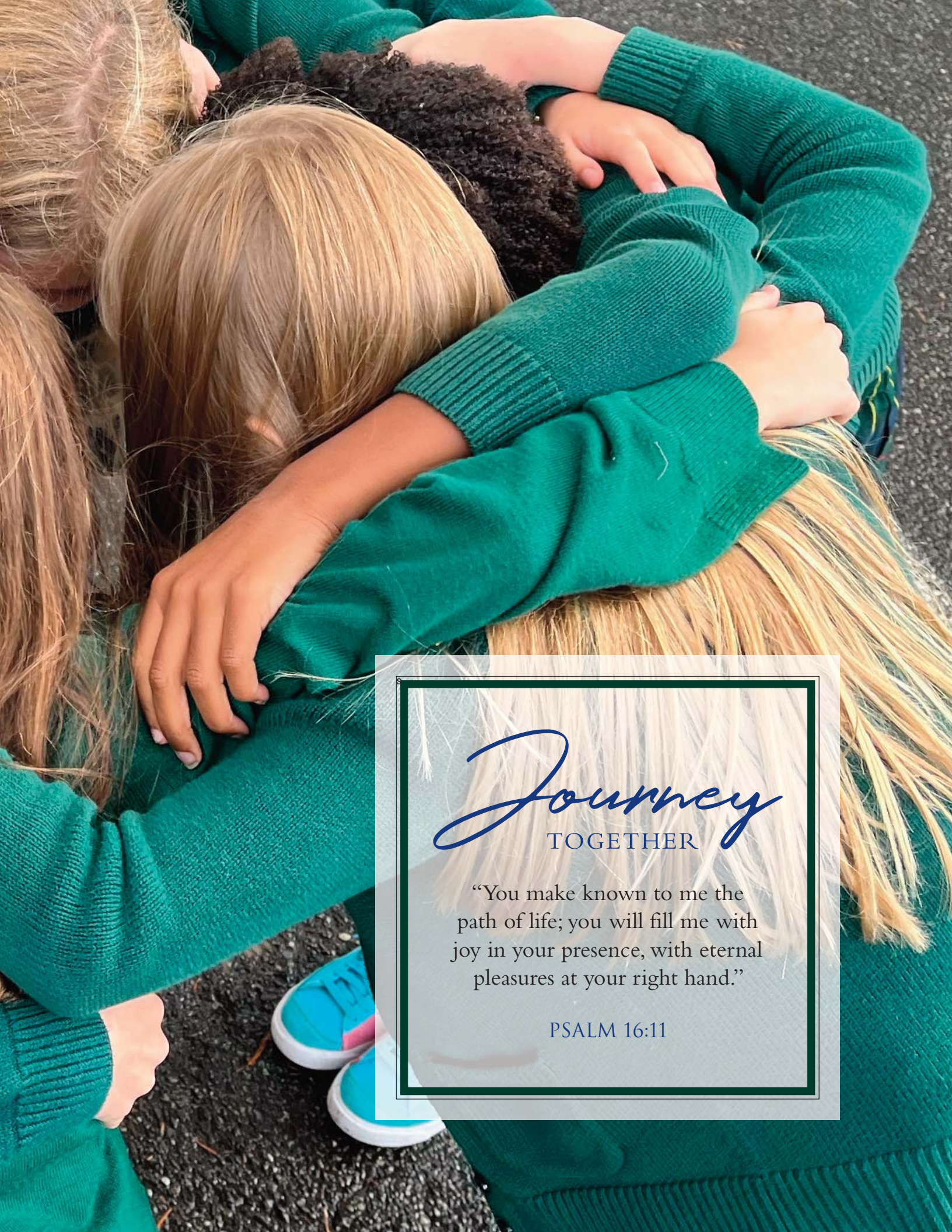

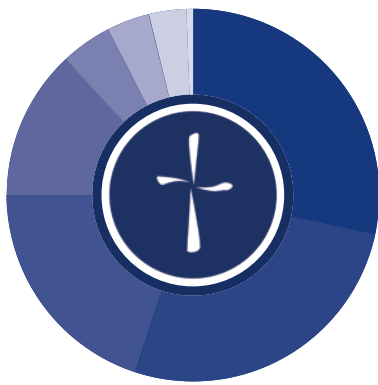

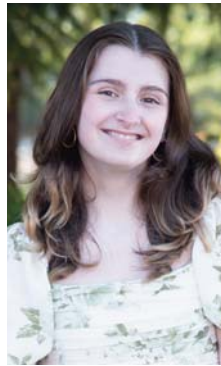
### LORI G MENDOZA AWARD – Matthew Craddock
