**Congratulations to Abigail Thompson our Shining Star Mentor!**

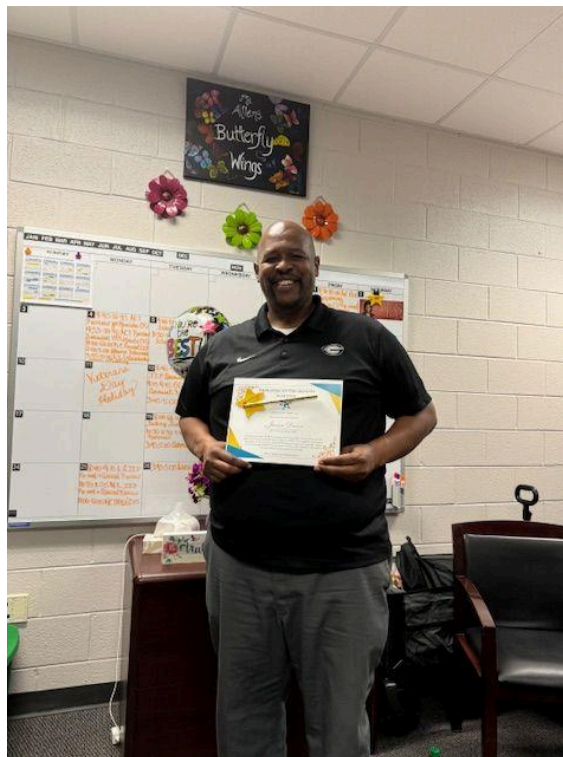
*CONGRATULATIONS*

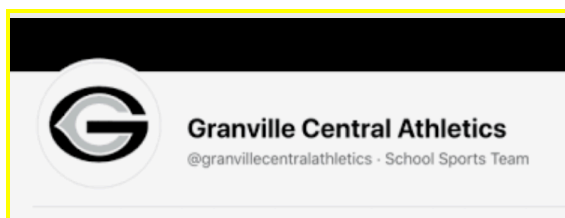
