# **CLUBS/EXTRA CURRICULARS**

**National Junior Honor Society**: Open to 8<sup>th</sup> graders who have a 3.33 or higher cumulative grade point average based on all four quarters of the student's seventh grade year and first quarter of their 8<sup>th</sup> grade year. Students must meet the criteria taken from the NJHS national standards.

representatives support and lead the school in many ways. Students need to be able to attend required after school meetings. Student council sponsors school activities, participates in fundraising projects and focuses on community service. \**Club Card*
