Congratulations to the boys and girls cross country teams on a fantastic season! Both teams qualified and competed at the IHSA state meet held at Detweiller Park in Peoria on Saturday, November 9, 2024. The 3A girls raced at 1pm and the boys at 2pm in wet and rainy conditions. The girls brought home an impressive 11th place finish in the state and the boys came home in 26th place. The girls were led by Ashley Schraeder's 34th place time of 17:36.60. Athena Triner ran a time of

17:41.90, Lily Camargo 18:02.50, Sophia Keeler 18:29, Sydney Seliga 18:46.10, Mia Evans 18:52.60, and Rachel Rotramel in 19:07.70. Leading the way for the boys was Owen Horeni's 17th place, All-State Finish, with a time of 14:28.60.
