Agenda

- Restoring access to Not Anymore training for ninth graders
 - Dr. McGowan will ask
 - 9th graders taking TSI in January
- What's the process and timeline for adding courses to crosswalk?
 - There has been authorization for courses such from FWISD (through TABS send) such as American Literature, but don't have authorization for CHEM 1406 yet from FWISD --- need approval still from TCC/ Ed Partnerships for other courses that are already authorized; TABS send Dr. Davis list and then Ed Partnerships can add it to crosswalk since not as formalized then we'll sent it through CurriculaLog
- Registration: Working with Dr. Schrantz on an issue with a spring section of Humanities. All juniors and seniors are registered for spring except: 6 who are trying to clear a hold, 1 that needs to decide what he is changing because his first and second choice are full. 9th graders taking TSI in Jan (right Brian) so their registration will be after testing. Munoz is working on 10th grade registration.
 - Option: Combined TABS section with blended, can add seats as needed; 10th graders not approved to do blended, need to be somewhere everyday. Don't have someone who can sit with them in blended. Juniors and seniors have more leeway; Mr Henson says 10th grade not ready yet for blended courses. Two options with Dr. Schrantz, 1 option is seats available in other periods; other option talk with Learning Commons as TABS not doing writing assignments – to arrange tutoring during off-day to help with the students. Is Learning Commons/Writing Commons space conducive to 10th graders? Dr. McGowan says writing center might be willing to do that, supervise for the Tuesday. T- TH, 2-3:20; this is for Humanities courses – Ms. Munoz develop CCMR skills with parents, auditing the list who are the students who get to the learning commons class. Perhaps a Supplemental Instruction person can work with the students (if not a writing center) ; class is Thursday, and Writing Center on Tuesdays. Ms. Asbury mentions issue with accountability ---- getting students to Learning Commons to know that they have to be there; if Learning Commons can structure . Can students – can check in and check out? Provide an opportunity for students to use TCC resources; Ms. Munoz suggests an orientation for SI/Learning Commons to know the expectations for this student group. GIVE IT A TRY!!! : students going to Writing Center during time when they are not in the classroom (hard to find classes to fit in last time slot/can't do 11-something)
- Preliminary TABS senior data: By May: 34 AA, 20 AS and 19 AA tracking to finish in the summer. 14 not

- What is the update on US History professors concerns over dropping students before the drop date? I have only seen one so far.
 - Each instructor has the right to drop students from class; if instructor sees student is having trouble --- can let them know. If professor wants to email TR.Dualcredit@tccd.edu about students having trouble they can do that and Dual Credit office will direct as necessary. Professor might not know if they are dropping TABS students (not supposed to identify who the students are). Not just showing Drop Report – but also attendance reports?
 - TCC ID? Send ID number if possible.
 - If professor can send to TR Inbox – can Deans suspect if a dual credit student -> send ID Number / name so TR ED Partnerships can address it.
 - Who are the students in US History? – [NAME REDACTED]
 - U.S. History is a High stress since students are STAAR tested– if we can get the names and find out if the history students are even TABS students– big watch list : US HISTORY
 - Dr. Davis- thank you for being part of the TABS counseling advisory council meeting Nov. 20th.
 - TCC/TABS luncheon and Chili Cookoff has been scheduled for Dec. 13th TRWF 5th floor. Room is reserved. Dr. Davis, can you please send in a request for 5-6 tables and some extra chairs for seating like last year, please.
 - 20 Chairs?
 - Meeting with Mulholland was successful. Invoice was sent to Dr. Davis and McGowan. Any concerns or issues with that quote sent 11/6?
 - It's fine
 - Asbury is currently working on a tour set up in the spring for TABS students to visit the TREC programs in small groups over multiple days. Exact dates are pending.
 - Partnership with TCC and Carter Blood Drives ,which now includes our PCT students as participants/volunteers is going well.
 - FAFSA/TASFA night scheduled for Dec. 3 from 6-9pm in the TABS café. TCC is expected to participate. TCC was also present for the FSA ID and FAFSA/TASFA overall presentation on Oct. 29th
 - It's been confirmed by Asbury that Financial Aid will be there
 - FYI- looks like DC PE has changed its meeting times to be all on one day. This does not allow TABS upperclassmen to use that class because of the scheduling issues on our side. This appears to be new for the spring semester.
 - This is just a small group of students that may be impacted as the students typically take PE 9th or 10th grade
 - Fingers crossed for the December grades. I know Dr. Davis said that has been taken away from their office but we will see how it goes. We have already been told that we won't get the spring semester grades from TCC until May 19th so our Val/Sal and top 10% students will not be available until 2 days before the last day of school. That's if we get them on the 19th of May. It will be a scramble!!

- Day that classes close, will send ISD unofficial grade. Around Dec 16th/ Dec 17th person in FWISD will get grades; professors will need to send actual grade (not just points, but out of 100 scale); find instructors who have Dual Credit students to send numeric grade. College 16th /// talk to Captain Albritton // reaffirms that students will be on Campus , Monday dec 16th is last day for TABS students. Tuesday Dec. 17th is prep day/ next two days are professional development. Friday Dec 20th Mr. Henson and Admin Assistant will be on campus.
- Dr. McGowan, please put May 16th and May 31st on your calendar. May 16th for the Senior Banquet (6-8pm) and May 31st for TABS graduation 11:30-1 at Wilkerson Greines. (I think you have these dates, but just making sure)
- There have been some student concerns about the speech teacher: [NAME REDACTED] but I haven't received anything specific that I can take to the dept chair. Saying offensive things that the students received as racist or disrespectful. Just an FYI at this point unless I can get something concrete.
- FYI- Dr. Davis had previously asked us if we wanted to have someone on our floor at table for Red Ribbon Week. There was no TCC representation here for the Red Ribbon Week.
- Communication to be provided if attendance by TCC is not possible/ is not happening
- For FALL 2025 need classes from TABS, TCC wants to start doing 8 weeks courses, TABS has an idea of what they want – need to communicate that to better position TABS so that the 16 week sections can be built; Learning Commons is to be worked with regarding plan to have students in Writing Center or SI for the day the students aren't class for blended class
