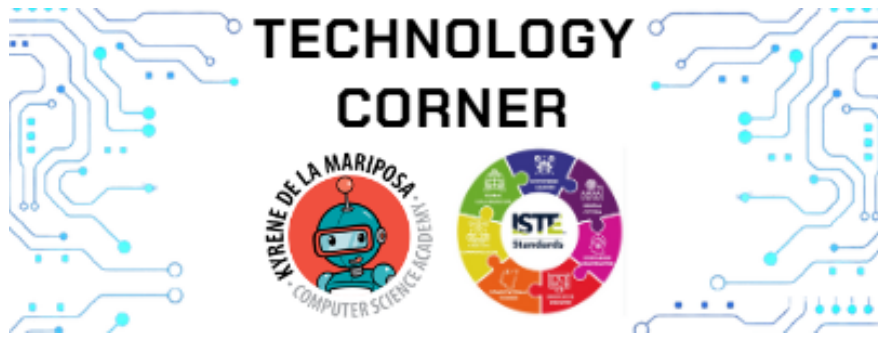

In an upcoming celebration of Computer Science Week, 1st grade students will be working on specific challenges showcasing their knowledge and learning of Early American Civilizations like the Mayans, Aztecs, and Incas. The students will be using different robotics like the Ozobots in order to code and help an Inca runner get a message across their empire. 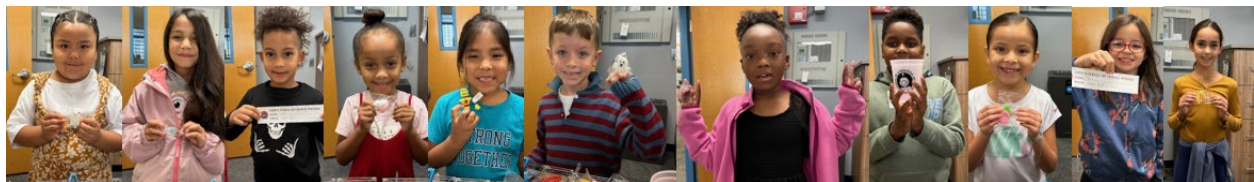
