PBIS is based on eight core components, including:

- Clarifying expected behaviors
- Teaching expected behaviors
- Encouraging expected behaviors
- Discouraging unwanted behaviors
- Ongoing monitoring
- Effective classroom practices

PBIS has three core values:

- Be Respectful,
- Be Responsible
- Be Safe
