Tips to Engage Your Children At Home

- Bake holiday treats! Allow your child to help with measuring ingredients to make your family's favorite holiday treats!
- Collect weather data each day and create a graph at the end of the month!
- Play "Mystery Number" using numbers from 0-50. One person thinks of a number and other asks yes/no questions such as, "Is it more than 20? Is it even or odd? Are there 2 digits or one?" etc.
- Draw a shape turkey! Have your child draw a turkey using only shapes (circle body, oval feathers, triangle feet, etc.).
