KINDERGARTEN

Exploring Numeracy (Numbers to 30)

The main focus of this unit is counting to 30, and identifying, representing, and comparing quantities up to 30.



Count the donuts. Write the number. How many are pink? How many are striped? How many have sprinkles?



Identify the penny, dime, nickel, quarter.
How much is 5 dimes?

FIRST GRADE

Counting and Numbers

The main focus of this unit is to build on the counting and place value strategies and understandings that were previously introduced, as well as identifying coins by their attributes and counting by fives to determine the value of coins.

SECOND GRADE

Measurement

We are continuing to focus on the standard units of measurement for length, weight/mass and volume. Students explore why we use standard units of measurement, how to select an appropriate unit of measurement, and what tools to use based upon the attribute being measured.
