## Spotlight on First Grade





In first grade, we have been learning how to find the missing part, using addition and subtraction. Students have learned many different strategies to help them do this! They can practice these skills at home anytime they have a snack or finger foods (fruit, veggies, etc).

In reading, students have working on digraphs (sh, ch, th, wh) and beginning/ending blends (st, bl, ng, nk, etc). Looking for these types of words when they are reading with you at home, will help them further their learning in these areas.
