All school activities will give proper consideration to the involvement of families. Delco Elementary has a Campus Academic Advisory Council (CAAC) consisting of parents, teachers, administrators, community members and other school staff.

 The committee will meet annually to update the Campus Parent and Family Engagement Plan. The goal is to have parents play a vital role in decision making regarding the Title I program. Delco Elementary will host an annual meeting for parents where information about Title I guidelines will be distributed.

 Parents are given copies of the current Parental Involvement Plan and are offered an opportunity to provide feedback. Parents have input on how Title I funds will be used; including funds for parental involvement activities.
 Volunteers may serve on district-wide and individual campus advisory committees. Translation will be provided so that all parents may participate.

Shared Responsibilities for High Student Academic Achievement

There are many ways in which parents can become involved with their children's education. Delco Elementary values both at-home contributions and those which take place at school and in the community. Many types of family engagement are needed in a school-home partnership to ensure that all children succeed.

 Delco Elementary is responsible for creating meaningful ways for families to be involved in their child's education.
 Some opportunities include Campus Academic Nights, Campus Advisory
 Teams, District Title I Parent Advisory
 Committee, Parent Information Nights, PTO's, and other school based groups.

Delco Elementary will communicate via: phone calls, emails, social media, memos, notes home, conferences and home visits as needed. Parents are encouraged to take the initiative to contact their child's teacher to monitor progress as well as when they have a concern.

Parents may request a translator for conferences. As much as possible, notices will be sent home in a language parents understand. School staff will also receive training on the importance of parental involvement and tips for communicating with parents.

Delco Elementary will provide assistance to parents in understanding topics such as academic content standards, state and local academic assessments including alternate assessments, how to monitor progress and how to work with educators.

 Opportunities for assistance will include campus Title I meetings, parent/teacher conferences, campus parent education sessions and campus parent and family engagement activities. Delco Elementary will share responsibility with families for high student academic performance by developing a school parent compact. This compact identifies how families, staff and students will share responsibility for improving student academic achievement.

 Parents of the school's CAAC will be involved in designing the compacts.
 Families will receive the compact which lists the responsibilities that teachers, parents and students will have for helping students achieve their goals.
 Parents and teachers are strongly urged to discuss the compact during conferences and with the students

Building Capacity

Delco Elementary will build school and family capacity to ensure effective engagement of parents and families. The school will support partnerships among the school, families and the community to improve student academic achievement.

 Efforts to build capacity include the Annual Title I Orientation Meeting in school, parent/teacher conferences, and campus parent education sessions, informational performance reports on district/state assessments, report cards, progress reports and explanation of test scores.

Evaluation

Delco Elementary will make an annual evaluation of the content and effectiveness of the parent and family engagement policy in improving the quality of its Title I Program. The evaluation will include identifying barriers to greater participation by parents in parental involvement activities. Delco Elementary will use the findings to design strategies for more effective engagement and to revise, if necessary (and with the involvement of parents), its parent and family engagement plans. The goal is to evaluate the Title I Program by collecting information in a variety of ways, including surveys, program evaluations and school report cards.
