Grandview High School Wall of Recognition Process

A “ Wall of Recognition” has been established at Grandview High School to honor Grandview High School graduates or attendees who have exhibited outstanding achievement in their lives.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- A graduate of Grandview High School or having completed the majority of his/her high school education at Grandview High School.
- At least ten years have elapsed since high school graduation.

NOMINATION: Each nomination should contain a detailed account of the individual’s accomplishments at Grandview High School and after graduation or enrollment at GHS to include:

- Education and Military Service
- Contribution to society
- Honors, Awards and authored publications
- Service to their community.

SELECTION CRITERIA: A rating scale of one (1) to eight (8), with one being low and eight being high, will be used for each of the following categories: Exemplary Achievement, Honors, and Awards, and Community Service.

Once a nominee is selected, the person submitting the nomination, the selectee, or his/her family, if a posthumous award) shall be responsible for providing a 8x10 photograph, portrait style “head shot” taken within the recent past (preferably within the last 10 years). The photo to be used is at the discretion of the committee. Also, please submit a biography of 250 words or less. Bios may be revised in coordination with the submitter by the Recommendation Committee to fit a limited space on the plaque.

Wall of Recognition Committee (WORC)

A committee shall be formed on an annual basis as determined by the Principal of Grandview High School or his/her designee. This volunteer committee should be comprised of Grandview High School graduates and should reflect a range of “class years” and exhibit diversity.

About the Committee:

- The WORC shall consist of 8 to 12 members.
- Each committee member shall serve at least 60 days before being allowed to vote on nominees.
- Members of the WORC cannot be nominated for the “Wall of Recognition” until one year after they resign or leave the committee.

The WORC shall:

- Select a Chairperson and a Vice Chairperson to serve for a period of two years. They shall be elected in June of the last year of the current chair’s term. The new chair shall serve from October to October and schedule meetings as they so determine. The chair will provide all WORC members complete copies of each nominee’s information.
- Nominations for recognition of Grandview High School Alumni must be submitted prior to Feb 25 each year.
- The importance of a group discussion requires that members must be present to score nominations. A quorum, is 1 more than ½ of the members on the committee.
- Scoring all nominations, individually, in a fair and unbiased manner using the rubric scoring system will be followed with 1 being low and 8 being high.
- The number of nominees selected for the Wall of Recognition will be determined by committee discussion and based on individual point totals, highest to lowest. The scoring and selection process or each year shall be completed on or before Mar 31.
- The WORC shall send a congratulatory letter, signed by the principal of Grandview High School, to each successful nominee by April 10 each year.

This letter will include detailed information about the recognition celebration at the Annual Dollars for Scholars / Wall of Recognition banquet.

- After selection the WORC shall coordinate with each submitter/selectee to obtain an appropriate 8x10 black and white photograph and an approximately 500 word biography. This to be provided to the committee by April 31.
- The WORC shall also send a letter to each submitter of those non-selected nominees by April 10. They will be encouraged to resubmit their nominee in the future.
