
























A Note from the Principal



Key School Updates and Reminders

Be Prepared: Increased Mountain Lion Activity in Boulder

As winter approaches, mountain lion activity near Boulder is expected to rise. While risks to humans are extremely low, taking precautions can help ensure safety. If you encounter a lion, stay





calm, talk firmly, and avoid running; instead, back away slowly and make yourself appear larger. To protect your property, install outdoor lighting, supervise pets and children (especially at dusk, dawn, or in the dark), and remove potential food sources like pet food or livestock access. Mountain lions are a natural part of the Front Range ecosystem, and relocation is reserved for animals

posing a direct threat to humans. For more safety tips or to report a sighting, visit the <u>Colorado</u> <u>Parks and Wildlife</u> or <u>City of Boulder</u> websites.
