Intro to Digital Music Production

Tuesdays, October 1-29, 4-6 PM

Intro to Digital Music Production is a 5 week hands-on course designed to teach students the fundamentals of creating hip-hop and EDM/Trap tracks using digital audio workstation software. Over five modules, participants will learn music theory basics, digital audio software skills, and techniques for building beats, chord progressions, and effects. By the end of the course, students will have produced their own tracks and gained the skills needed for entry-level music production.




Film Production Lab

Wed, September 25-De 11, 4-6 PM

(No class on Nov 27)

In this 11-week intensive film production experience, students who have previously taken a class with the Teen Storytellers Project will dive deeper into the filmmaking process, focusing on bringing a short film from script to screen. During the first 2-hour session students will collaboratively select a script that will guide the course's production. Over the following weeks, participants will engage in hands-on learning in their key production roles—such as directing, cinematography, sound, and editing—while also refining their storytelling skills. By week 10, students will have completed a fully produced short film, ready for presentation and feedback.
