Dear Parent/Guardian,,

We are writing to inform you about the Georgia School Climate Survey that will be conducted at your child’s school. The survey, which will be open from December, 2024 through March, 2025, includes 73 questions. It should take students approximately 25 minutes to complete, and it asks about the quality of teaching and learning, the school environment, support for students, how commonly students in the school face challenges (such as being bullied), and student risk behaviors (such as self-harm and substance abuse). Names cannot be tied to survey answers in any way, and students can skip any question. The data will help leaders improve the school.

The Protection of Pupil Rights Amendment (PPRA), 20 U.S.C. §1232(c)(1)(A) gives you the right to review a copy of the student survey questions. You may review the survey questions at [this link](#). Additionally, you may request that the school provide a copy of the survey questions for your review.
