CSMS COUNSELING: 8th GRADE ACADEMIC @ CAREER PLANS

Our school counselors visited eighth grade English classrooms to help each student create an Academic & Career Plan (otherwise known as ACP). Students completed their ACP within a program called Major Clarity, where each student created an academic plan for high school (grades 9-12). In addition, each student was asked to enter a career goal.

During the classroom visits, counselors discussed/reviewed summer school course considerations, Burton Center for Arts & Technology programs, and Governor's School.
