

Enrollment Instructions

Verify your child's assigned school at *stillwaterschools.org/map*. Click on the magnifying glass in the upper left corner and type in your home address. Click on the map and your designated school will appear in the upper left column.



Grab a copy of your child's birth certificate.



Go to *stillwaterschools.org/k-enroll*. Select the "ENROLL" button in English or Spanish to go to the enrollment portal.

- **a.** If this is your first time enrolling a student you will need to create an account.
- **b.** If you have enrolled a student previously, use those credentials to sign in.

Once logged in, enter the student's name and date of birth and select the "ADD STUDENT" button.



Fill out the online enrollment form and upload required documents. Answer all questions to the best of your ability (some questions may not be relevant to you). We will contact you if we need clarification.

Things to Know:

- If you are interested in attending a school outside of your attendance area or applying for Amigos Unidos (Spanish Immersion) be sure to also submit the Alternate Enrollment Form and/ or the Amigos Unidos Application. Families who apply by Jan. 15 will have priority.
- Regardless of the school selected by the family, students will be enrolled in their assigned school. The Enrollment Office approves alternate enrollment based on space available. Entrance into Amigos Unidos is based on a tiered lottery.

To Do:

Enroll: Now through January 15*

Enroll online at *stillwaterschools.org/k-enroll* and upload a copy of your child's birth certificate.

Get Screened

Early Childhood Screening is a state requirement. The free evaluation will assess your child's vision, hearing, speech motor and thinking skills, as well as general health and growth. Schedule an appointment at *stillwaterschools.org/screening* or call 651-351-4022.

December-January: School Tours

Before First Day of School: Schedule a Health Examination

Have your doctor complete a School Health Examination Form (strongly suggested) and Immunization Record or signed waiver (required). Submit these forms at least one week prior to the start of school. Enroll and get a Class
