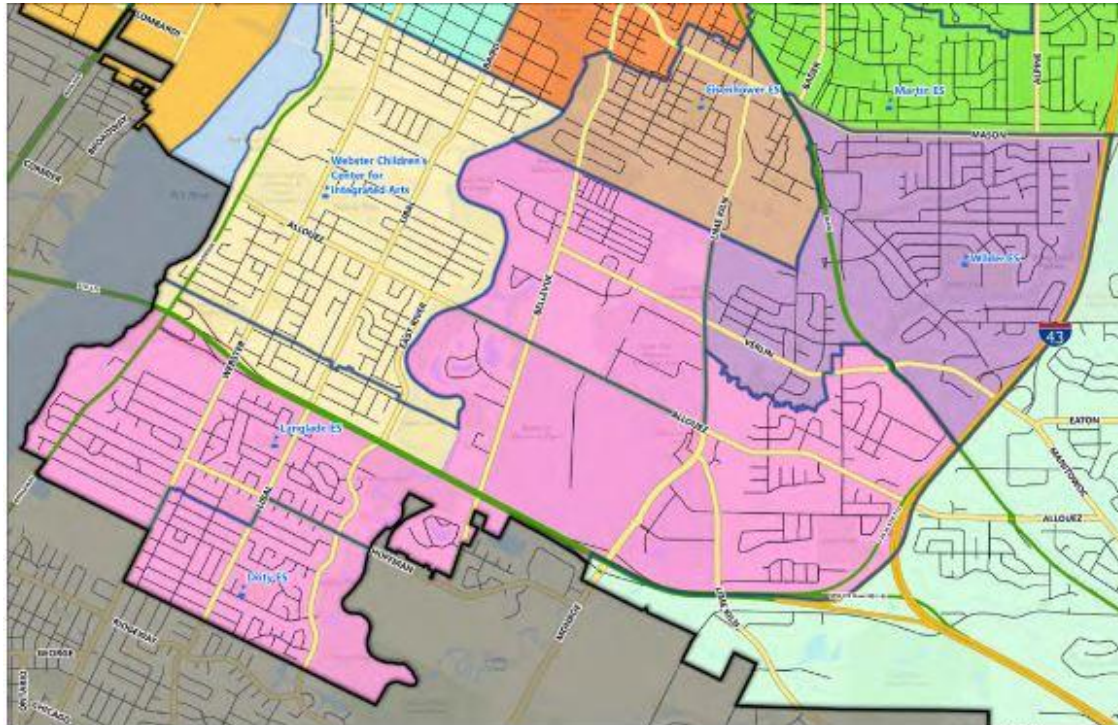

- 2023-24 enrollment at Doty = 277

Schedule

- **Preliminary Schedule (subject to change)**
 - Design through spring of 2025
 - Phase 1 construction planned to begin summer of 2025
 - Phase 2 construction planned to begin summer of 2026
 - Construction to be completed for start of the 2026 school year
