Academic Accomplishments

North Myrtle Beach High School provides a safe, nurturing, and academically competitive learning environment that is innovative and student-centered. This environment is provided through the implementation of our school's vision: to be recognized as one of the premier schools in one of the nation's premier school systems, in which every student receives an excellent education. North Myrtle Beach High School demonstrates this vision by offering a variety of opportunities in both academics and extracurricular activities for students to take advantage of to broaden experiences and foster talents. In addition to core academic courses, students have opportunities to study in the areas of business, culinary arts, dual-enrollment courses through Horry Georgetown Technical College, Advanced Placement Courses, STEM courses, visual arts, performing arts, band, orchestra, Spanish, and Naval Junior ROTC. Extracurricular opportunities such as drama, robotics, book club, band, orchestra, student council, Beta Club, National Honor Society, Mu Alpha Theta, English Honor Society, Social Studies Honor Society, Science Honor Society, International Thespian Society, Spanish Honor Society, ROTC, Christmas Angels, and athletics give students opportunities to engage in community service opportunities while building experiences.

Last year, during the 2023-2024 school year, NMBH's Algebra students had the fifth-highest passage rate on the State End of Course Exam in South Carolina. For the 2024-2025 school year, the school's CTE offerings were expanded, adding an Essentials of Engineering course to the Project Lead the Way courses, which already included Intro to Engineering Design, Computer Science Principles, Civil Engineering and Architecture, and Principles of Biomedical Sciences. The student body has brought many accomplishments and honors to NMBHS. The Class of 2024 generated over \$12.1 million in scholarships. Our AP test pass rates remain at or above state and global percentages.

North Myrtle Beach High School offers dual-enrollment courses as part of its Program for Accelerated College Enrollment through Horry-Georgetown Technical College, as well
