Academic Opportunities

The Academy for Technology and Academics (ATA) is a nationally recognized and accredited STEM School, and we received STEM certification from Cognia in 2024. ATA is a two-year, majors-based program that provides hands-on STEM-embedded training opportunities with work-based learning and internships. ATA offers 10 major programs that support student career and post-secondary goals. Students may earn a license or certification through one of our career major programs, which may reduce or eliminate the need to take post-secondary classes. Our Major pathways include Automotive Technology, Barber/Master Hair Care, Building Construction, Cosmetology, Culinary Arts Management, Esthetics/Nail Technician, Health Science (Nursing/CNA), Health Science (Pre-Medicine), HVAC Technician, and Pre-Engineering (Siemens). By choosing a major at ATA, students apply rigorous academic content while acquiring the skills necessary for success in their chosen career pathways. Students attend ATA to pursue individual interests, participate in experiences such as networking through work-based learning, and earn industry-recognized licenses or credentials necessary for college and career readiness.

In addition, ATA offers Advanced Placement (AP), Honors, and College Prep classes as well as dual-enrollment/PACE classes through our partnership with Horry Georgetown Technical College (HGTC).

Entrance Requirements

High school students interested in a major/pathway offered at ATA may apply online via the Horry County Schools website during their 10th-grade year to attend ATA for their 11th- and 12th-grade years. Some programs may have additional requirements in conjunction with state requirements for certain licenses or certifications. Students must adhere to the district's deadline dates for their application submission. Accepted students must return their acceptance agreement commitment form by the deadline.



Academic Accomplishments & Recognitions

ATA has been recognized as a high-performing career center in South Carolina. We have a College and Career Readiness Rating of 98%, which includes students earning their license or certification, and we have maintained at least a 98% Graduation Rate by our seniors as they graduate from their base high school. Additionally, 100% of Cosmetology and Nursing students earned their state license or certification before graduation.





ATHLETICS & FINE ARTS PROGRAMS

Students are eligible to participate in the athletics and other extracurricular activities offered at their base high school if those extracurricular activities are not offered at ATA.

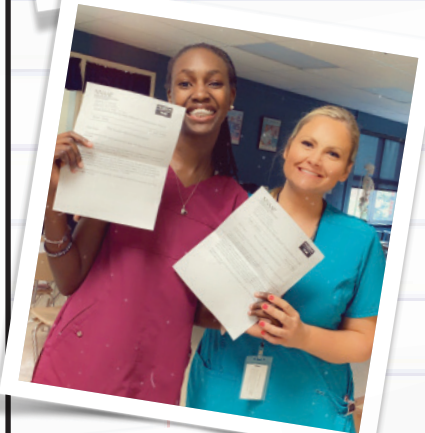
