Termination of Agreement

- A. The term of this Agreement shall commence as of the date signed by both parties, as indicated below, and shall terminate three (3) years after such date (the "Term"), unless otherwise extended by mutual written agreement. Notwithstanding the foregoing, either party may terminate this Agreement at any time, with or without cause, by providing one hundred eighty (180) days' written notice to the other party. Notwithstanding any early termination of this Agreement, as provided in the preceding sentence, the parties shall allow participating students enrolled at CCAC as of the effective date of the termination to continue their education under the terms of this Agreement until their educational program is complete.
- B. In the event that either party makes any change in or to the curriculum, standards, name or CIP codes for a course(s) or program(s) articulated under this Agreement, either by its own action or as a result of or in response to any change in applicable law, regulation or accreditation standards, then the parties agree that (i) the party making the change shall notify the other party in writing of the change as soon as practicable, but no later than thirty (30) days prior to the date that the change will take effect; (ii) this Agreement shall be deemed to be terminated as of the effective date of such change; and (iii) the parties will meet prior to the date that the change is scheduled to become effective in order to conduct a full review of both CCAC and the School's curriculum and to develop an updated or revised agreement to succeed this Agreement.





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
