1. Teacher Residency Program (R)

Nicole Kukral, Director, Professional Learning and Innovation, and Kalei Eskridge, Teacher Residency Facilitator, shared the presentation on the San Juan Teacher Residency Program. The residents earn their teaching credential and master's degree in one year. The focus areas are staffing hard to fill positions, building career pathways and diversifying the workforce.

2. San Juan Rules of Order and Committee Norms (D)

Ms. Kukral shared with the committee that she, Myel Thelen, and Margaret Teichert, C&S Committee members, attended a Board Committee Training in September, where they went over the San Juan Unified Rules of Order. Ms. Kukral shared the rules and had the committee review them, then held a discussion/questions session. The committee came back needing some clarification on several of the questions, and Ms. Kukral will gather the information and bring it back to the committee.

3. Approval of Minutes – October 2, 2024
