CERAMICS 1 (grades 9-12)

While working with clay, you are making objects with your hands, allowing your creative side to come out. You will learn techniques, vocabulary, the basics of handbuilding, and glazing your projects. Grading is based on effort and completing projects in clay. While working with your hands, you will allow your creative side to come out.

CERAMICS 2 (grades 10-12)

You will start developing more advanced techniques, using the potters wheel, making larger projects and developing your personal style in clay. Students will continue to develop skills and will be challenged as artists creatively.

ADVANCED CERAMICS (grades 11-12)

This class will give you an opportunity to use your prior knowledge and experience for deeper and broader understanding of clay. You will be introduced to more complex concepts and vocabulary.



Ceramics is a craft made to be beautiful, admired for its perfection of form and materials and for its unique expression of its makers. The craft of ceramics involves making objects from clay. It can be pinched, pulled, stretched, rolled, kneaded, and pushed into shape by your hands. You will create many things to keep.
