II. Welcome Opening and Attendance	Chairperson Chris Schwartz welcomed the committee members. Twelve (12) members were in attendance, which met the quorum. Seven (7) other attendees were present. Next, the Chairperson reviewed the District's Pillars of Excellence, meeting norms, and the purpose of the District Advisory Committee (DAC).

Director of Professional Development, Ms. Rachele Montoya shared the 2024-2027 LCAP and let the group know that the DAC was the first group to hear the sharing of LCAP. Ms. Montoya explained Data Snapshot and went over five pillars. She informed the DAC of how the District had chosen the LCAP goals. Next, Ms. Montoya explained how the District paid attention to survey data from staff, educational partners, SBAC data, and the student advisory committee. She shared that the LCAP writing team focused on the most essential/top concern(s) or wants from surveys: qualified/well-trained Principals/teachers, school safety, positive behavior, & anti-bullying programs, & cleaner schools. Also, Ms. Montoya reminded the group that this LCAP has three broad goals & 1 focus goal. Lastly, she mentioned that the LCAP will be presented at the board meeting on June 11 and requested board approval on June 25.
