OSBA Board of Directors Position No. 9— Douglas / South Coast Region

The School Board voted to approve Director Steve Hammerson as a candidate for OSBA Position No. 9 for the Douglas / South Coast region. Each school district may cast one vote for a candidate for terms effective January 1, 2025.

The Board directed the district to implement ORS 329.078 "Informational Surveys" through parent notification and choice to participate.

APPROVAL OF CM/GC CONTRACTOR FOR RHS VO-TECH EAST BUILDING SEISMIC RENOVATION

The School Board unanimously approved S+B James Construction to serve as contractor for the seismic rehabilitation project for the Roseburg High School Vo-Tech east building. The proposed fees for pre-construction phase are \$26,124 and \$125,662 for the construction phase. Business Operations was directed to proceed with contract negotiations.

Photocopier Services Contract Extension

The Board unanimously approved a recommendation from Purchasing Services to extend our copier agreement/upgrade with Pacific Office Automation (POA) through April 30, 2029.

RESOLUTION 24-25-10

The Board, in accordance with Oregon Budget Law, ORS 294. 326(3) unanimously approved the acceptance of an unanticipated increase in the Student Investment Account grant funds in the amount of \$1,106,000 and appropriated them to Instruction, Support Services and Facilities.

STUDENT INVESTMENT ACCOUNT (SIA) / INTEGRATED PROGRAMS—Annual Report

Asst. Supt. Michelle Knee shared the 2023/24 Final Report for SIA and Integrated Programs that target support for student mental and behavioral health; increasing academic achievement; reducing disparities for students from racial or ethnic groups that historically experienced academic disparities; students with disabilities; English Language Learners; students who are foster children and students who are homeless. Michelle also revisited four strategies utilized here at RPS, such as investments in Class Size, Well Rounded Education, Instructional Time, and Health and Safety. The final 2023-2024 SIA grant totaled \$5,250,236.98. The 2024-2025 final allocation is \$5,475,173.88
