Position Summary:

Branksome Hall Asia is seeking to fill part time instrumental tuition teacher positions in the Junior School for the 2024-25 school year as it trials the expansion of its instrumental tuition program. With strong communication and instrumental teaching skills as well as a proven ability to build a caring rapport with students, the successful candidate will work closely with the Performing Arts department to deliver high quality, small group instrument lessons in English and Korean.

We are seeking teachers of the following instruments,

(the ability to teach multiple instruments is preferred)

Voice, violin, cello, flute, clarinet, saxophone, oboe, bassoon, percussion, guitar, all brass instruments.

Responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Create a class environment that inspires and supports learning and personal growth.
- Establish effective rapport with students, based on mutual respect and positive interactions.
- Motivate students to develop skills, attitudes, and knowledge needed to make healthy progress on their chosen instrument.
- Communicate information regularly to students, colleagues, and parents regarding student progress including a short termly report.
- Work with the Performing Arts department to support your students in preparing for performances in concerts and assemblies.
- Communicate effectively with the Music assistant and Performing Arts director regarding students, lesson structure and timetables.

Ideal Qualifications and Experience:

- Relevant teaching experience on your chosen instrument(s)
- Experience teaching small groups of students in grades 3-7
- Experience planning 30 minute small group lessons that are tailored to the age and need of the students.
- Experience in working with complete beginners as well as intermediate level students (The ability to work with more advanced students may be desired in the future)
- Strong oral and written communication skills in both English and Korean.
- Ability to play your chosen instruments at a very high level.
- Ability to work independently with little direct supervision and as part of a team
- Demonstrated strong work ethic and reliability in part-time hours
- Effective multitasking and time management skills

Length of Term: 1 Term (12 weeks) initial contract with an option to renew for the 2025-2026 academic year. Lessons will take place between 9-3pm starting from 10th February.
