Putting 11 players into the scoring column, Crockett County's Lady Cavaliers opened the high school basketball season Tuesday night in Jackson by crushing North Side 69-29.

Coach Kayla Irvin's club zoomed to a 16-7 first-quarter lead, which it stretched to 34-15 by halftime. A 22-point third period ended any debate about the eventual winner.

Senior post player Amaria Walker sparked an extremely balanced offensive attack with 14 points. Sharpshooting sophomore Jordyn Maddox added 12 and netted two of Crockett's five three-pointers. Senior Karlee Castellaw contributed nine points and a slew of assists, finding teammates both in transition and in set plays.

Point guard Gabby Bursey scored seven, reserve post Kira Bray six, Keeton Holyfield and Torey Savage five apiece, and Ellie Henderson four for the Lady Cavaliers. Audrey Whitby added a three-pointer for the winners.

In the doubleheader nightcap, one difference was that North Side's boys had their full complement of football athletes, while Crockett - whose gridders haven't had much practice time, since their season just ended Friday night - didn't even dress out its footballers. The host Indians prevailed 68-48, jumping to a quick 25-12 edge in the first quarter and eventually putting the game away with a 23-8 run in the third.

North Side football star Javonte Smith paced the Indian onslaught with 13 points. Another gridder, AJ Currie, drilled in four treys for North Side for his 12 points. Lincoln Woods also netted 12 for the winners.

For Crockett, Jayden Frye nailed a trio of threes and finished with 11 points to top the Cavs. Reed Leforgee had 10 points in his first game as a Cav, and Cade Freeman tallied nine, including seven from the free throw line. Grayson Lambert contributed six points before spraining his ankle in the final period. Kevin Pledge and Andre Garduno scored five each


