## GUIDELINES FOR EARLY DISMISSAL DUE TO ILLNESS



Students with any of the following health issues should be sent to the schoolDoctor's office to be evaluated. It is mandatory that the student be sent home early from school if any of these issues are present.

## EARLY DISMISSAL OF A STUDENT IS INDICATED WHEN:

- He/she has fever 99.5 °F (37.5 °C) or higher.
- He/she has diarrhea 2 or more times throughout the school day.
- He/she has one or more episodes of vomiting due to illness. \*
- He/she has a disruptive cough and constant runny nose with yellow/green tint.
- He/she has a rash (body and/or face) or pus-filled blisters that suggest apossible skin infection.
- He/she has symptoms of an eye infection with redness, itching and/or eye drainage.
- He/she has a newly diagnosed case of lice.
- \* Special circumstances may arise, and it will be up to the discretion of theschool Doctor to decide whether early dismissal is indicated. The student's parents will be notified of the decision and general recommendations will be given.
