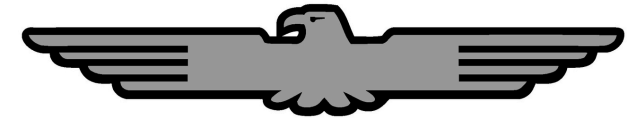

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Our Goals for Student Achievement

At the end of the 24/25 school year, we will see a 3% increase on the NWEA MAP assessment ELA and Math Performance Indicator from the 2024 Median Percentile score.

School Goal and Focus

Increase student levels of proficiency in ELA by having 70% or more students K-5 score proficient or above as measured by MAP Assessments or GKIDS for Kindergarten

Focus on developing Writing, Reading comprehension and vocabulary skills

In the Classroom

- Teachers will facilitate multiple Family Engagement Meetings with families to provide individualized and group data regarding benchmark skills.
- Teachers will send home sight word lists and specific activities for students to practice at home.
