**3 Year Old students can opt into part-time learning options: half day, 5 days a week or full day, 3 days a week for \$14,511 (general) and \$16,613 (corporate). All part-time students participate in the lunch program.

***ISI works closely with international and domestic program partners to offer language and culture trips. These trips are not currently required as a part of the curriculum, though all students are encouraged to participate in travel opportunities. Given uncertainties worldwide related to travel, and because visa issuance, costs for flights, hotels, and insurance can vary throughout the year, ISI publishes trip offerings and all associated fees annually based on the most expensive scenario, meaning final costs may be lesser than the published total presented here.

Cost of Lunch

Students receive a hot lunch every day.

Books

All needed books are included in tuition.

Technology Fees

Fees are used to fund IT support, classroom sets of iPads at the Lower School, standardized testing Chromebooks at the Upper School, and other support for in-person and remote learning as needed.

Activity Fees

In-school club activities are free to students.

Local Field Trips

Lower School students go on multiple field trips a year, including visits to local museums, BizTown, and nature centers.

Student Support Services

SSS works with students to reach academic, social, and emotional goals through collaboration between students, teachers, and families.

Parent Association Support

\$25 of each student's tuition supports planning and managing volunteer support for ISI community events each year.

College Counseling Services

College Counseling at ISI begins in Grade 9. Activities included in tuition include (but are not limited to): One-on-one and group meetings, resume, application, essay, and interview workshops, PSAT and PSAT practice meetings, scholarship search support, in-school visits from 60-100 universities yearly.
