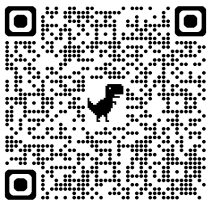

The theme for this year's [Lifting Up Westchester's 8th Annual Essay](#) writing contest is *The Gift*. Students are asked to write an essay based on the prompt:

- *Imagine that Lifting Up Westchester has received an unexpected monetary gift of one million dollars and you must decide how to allocate this money to best serve our community.*

Any 7th-12th grade student attending school in Westchester is eligible to enter the contest, and a cash prize will be awarded to the top entrants! The deadline for essay submission is **February 7, 2025, any essays turned in after this date will not be eligible**.
