What Kids Learn in Preschool

Kids learn a lot of important things in PreK, like how to ...

Get along with others

We help kids learn how to be good students by teaching them to share, participate in groups, follow instructions and make friends - all important skills needed in school and life!

Solve problems and learn new things

Play is the main way children learn and develop ideas about the world around them. Students are encouraged to be curious, and teacher's use the child's interests and ideas to create activities for them that build pre-math, science and literacy skills.

Take care of themselves

Preschool is a place where kids can gain a sense of self, explore, get along with peers, and build confidence and independence. It's also important for children to spend time away from parents and build trusting relationships with adults outside the family.

Communicate and think deeply

Our teachers help kids develop their language skills by asking thought-provoking questions and introducing new vocabulary throughout the day. Kids also engage in hands-on activities that challenge them to observe closely, ask questions, and test their ideas.

Develop physical skills

Young children are in motion for a good part of the day. Our preschools provide several opportunities daily for children to run, climb, and play active games. Activities are also offered to help children develop fine motor skills, such as threading beads or cutting with scissors.

3-4 YEARS OLD?

Now is the time to screen!



Early Childhood Screening is a FREE, simple check of how your child is growing, developing and learning. State law requires children to be screened, and screening early is best so that any health or development concerns can be addressed right away.

What to expect during screening:

Your child will complete developmental activities with a trained professional to see if they're meeting important milestones specific to their age. They'll check:

- Vision and hearing
- Height and weight
- Immunizations
- Large and small muscles
- Thinking, language and communication skills
- Social and emotional development
