- Approved <u>AN-2186:Cybersecurity Grant and Selected Solution</u> awarded to Sentinel Technologies of Downers Grove, Illinois, a 2-year contract not to exceed \$208,725.00 for the purchase of cybersecurity endpoints for district-managed devices and professional services to support the project implementation with funding provided by the SLCGP Grant, Bond Program Fund and General Fund.
- 2. Approved AN-2183: Haisley and King Elementary School Playground Equipment Replacement purchase of two (2) Nuin-3444 play structures with 360-degree slide and comet spinner for King and Haisley Elementary Schools in the total the amount of \$98,098 from Snider Recreation through the Omnia Cooperative Purchasing Program. This purchase will be funded by the Sinking Fund.
