

Please check the lost and found for any missing items. Items not claimed are donated monthly to charity.







Please review the Exclusion for Illness Procedures that are currently in place in the Horry County School System. This includes preschool, elementary, middle and high schools. Many students are coming to school will fevers, congestion and sore throats. Sending your child to school sick increases the chances of other students becoming ill. Sending your child sick to school increases the chances of other students becoming ill.

Children become sick quickly, and infections spread easily among children. With this in mind, please look for any of the symptoms as outlined below, that would require your child to remain home for the day, or to be removed from the school setting. When in doubt, I encourage you to keep your child at home for the day. This will aid in decreasing illness among all of the children.

### Symptoms Requiring Your Child to Remain at Home or Be Removed from the Classroom

FEVER:	Fever is defined as having a temperature of 100.5°F or higher. The child MUST be FEVER FREE for a minimum of 24 hours-without the use of medication-before returning to school.
DIARRHEA:	Runny, watery or bloody stools. Keep home for 24 hours after LAST diarrhea
VOMITING:	2 or more times in a 24-hour period. Keep home for 24 hours after LAST episode
BODY RASH WITH FEVER:	Body rashes in children can be common. However, if the rash is accompanied by a fever, the child should remain home until the rash is diagnosed or resolves.
SORE THROAT:	If your child is diagnosed with Strep Throat, the child MUST be on antibiotics for a minimum of 24 hours before returning to school.
EYE DISCHARGE:	Thick mucus or pus draining from the eye, or "Pink Eye". Antibiotics or antibiotic ointment should be administered for 24 hours before returning to school.
IRRITABILITY:	Child is irritable, continuously crying, or requires more attention than the teacher can give without hurting the health and safety of other children in the classroom.
EARACHE:	Children experience extreme pain with earaches and should remain at home. If infection is present, student may return after first dose of medication is given if prescribed.
RUNNY NOSE AND/OR COUGH:	Children experience runny noses frequently during the winter and spring months. However, if your child has thick, yellow or green discharge, or requires frequent/constant wiping of the discharge, or has an excessive, uncontrollable cough the child should remain home.
HEAD LICE:	When a case of lice is identified, the parent will be notified and the child should be treated, and ALL of the nits removed. The student should be retreated in seven to ten days.
