

INAPPROPRIATE IMAGES, HARMFUL CONTENT, AND UNSAFE CONVERSATIONS

REPORT: If you receive explicit images or violent content, tell a trusted adult, school staff, law enforcement, or Cowley County Crime Stoppers right away.

DON'T SHARE: Reposting or sharing harmful content can cause serious stress and harm to those affected.

TAKE ACTION: After reporting, delete the content or block the sender on social media.

HELP A FRIEND: If a friend shares thoughts of self-harm or harming others, always report it to a trusted adult.

Contact 988 in cases of mental health crisis.

SEE SOMETHING, SAY SOMETHING

Anonymously report inappropriate or concerning behavior on Crimestoppers or report it to local law enforcement.



SEXTING PREVENTION TIPS

TRUST YOUR GUT

Trust your instincts. If something feels off, don't pass it along.

DON'T GIVE IN

Never feel pressured to do something to 'earn' love. Take a moment to think, seek advice from someone you trust, and remember – if it doesn't feel right, it's not worth it.

NOTHING IS ANONYMOUS

Digital communication isn't truly anonymous – almost everything can be traced back to its source through cell phones or the internet.

NO MEANS NO

No means no. When it comes to sexual activity, sexting, or any kind of pressure, remember that 'no' is a complete sentence. Respect it and honor the boundaries of others.

RED FLAGS

WARNING SIGNS OF ONLINE PREDATORS

- Using sexual talk or role-play to groom.
- Requesting or exchanging explicit photos.
- Building trust with compliments, shared interests, or likes.
- Sending explicit photos.
- Pretending to be younger.
- Offering gifts, alcohol, drugs, or other incentives like rides or food.

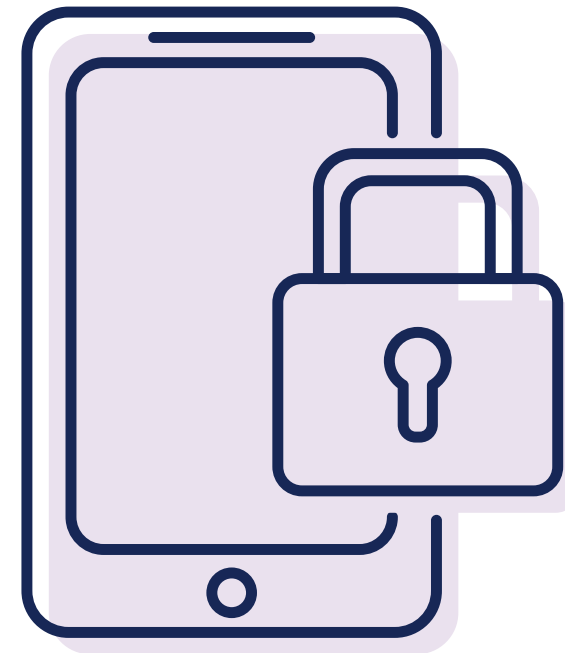
