- **REVERE COMMUNITY C.A.R.E. 11/25/24 "INTERNET SAFETY" PARENT PROGRAM** Revere Community C.A.R.E. is sponsoring a free program on "Internet Safety" – for parents and other interested adults – on Monday, November 25, 2024, 6:30-8:00 p.m., in the cafeteria at Revere Middle School. It will be presented by Justin Rotili – who is a special investigator with the ICAC Task Force, a task force officer with Homeland Security Investigations, and a member of the Cuyahoga County Prosecutor's Office Ohio Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force – and Revere SRO Scott Dressler. No advance registration is required. Attached is a flyer you can use to help promote this program with others you think might be interested in attending.
- **A Note from the Clinic:** When Should Your Child Stay Home From School? Children should be kept home if they have diarrhea, vomiting, severe coughs, severe colds, or undetermined rashes. Children should not come to school with a temperature of 100 degrees or above. The temperature should stay below 100 degrees without fever-reducing medication for 24 hours before returning to school. In addition, children should not return to school for 24 hours if they have diarrhea or vomiting.
- **Nov 27-Dec 2nd : No school for students or staff.** Thanksgiving Break is Nov 27-29 (Wed-Fri) and the following Monday (Dec 2nd) is conference payback day. Staff are given that day off to compensate for the additional evening hours during conferences. [Revere School District Calendar is here.](#)

As you are planning for upcoming classroom parties please know that all party volunteers must have a background check on file with the district. 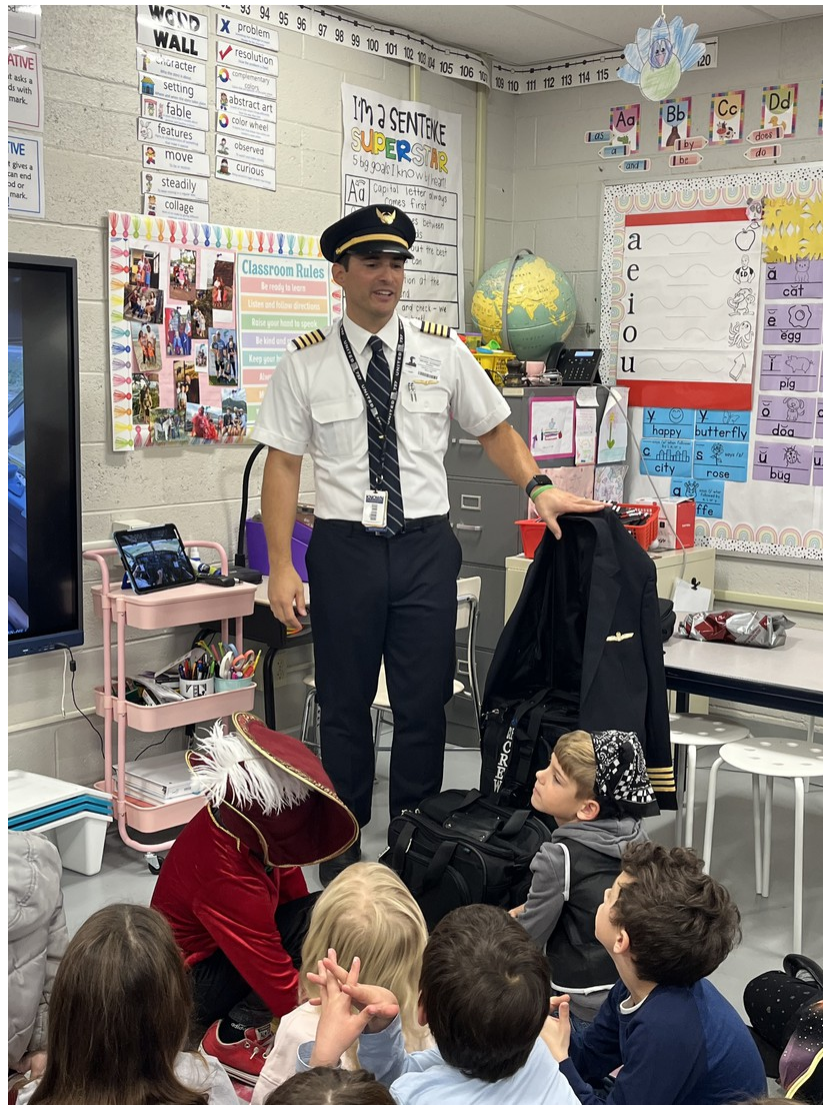
