We are grateful for your input and look forward to the opportunity to collaborate with all of you in shaping the future of our schools and facilities. Thank you for being a part of this important process.

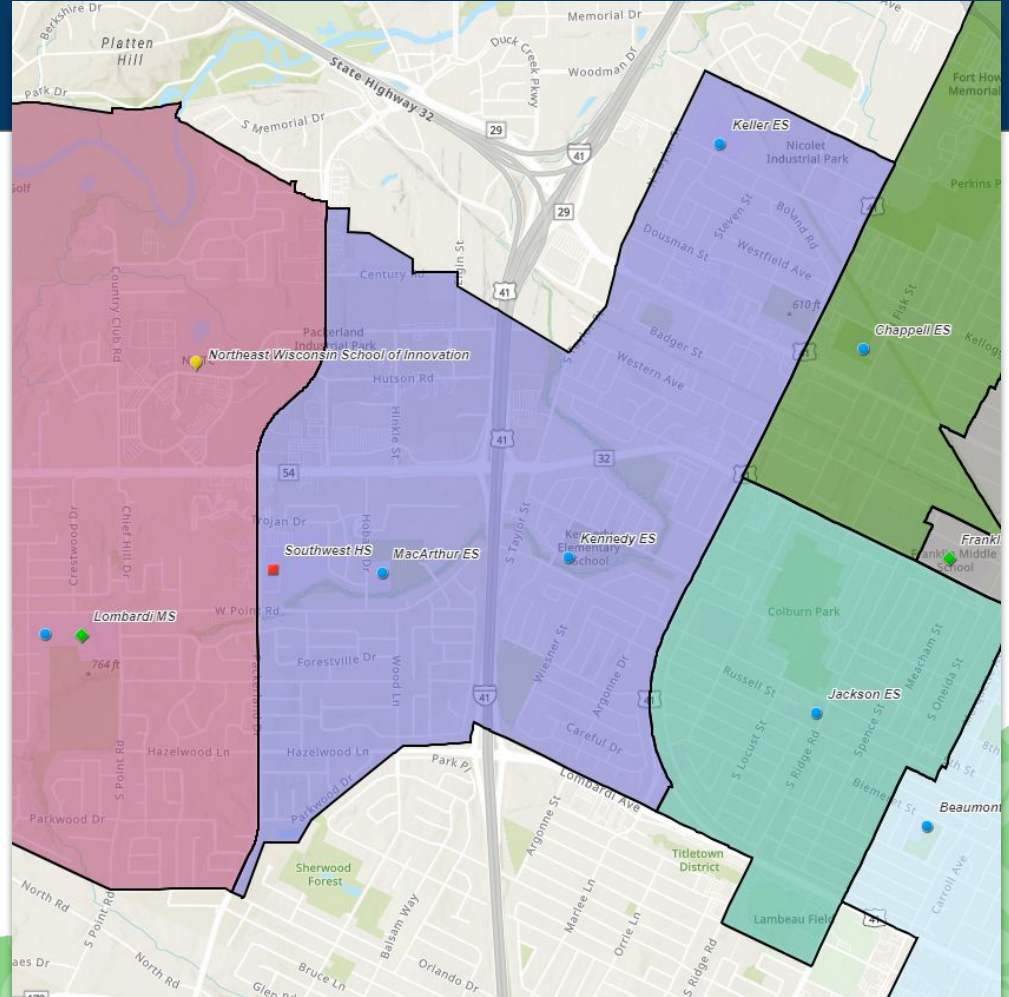
Objective

 - Input will be used to refine project design

Boundary Change

- New boundary for west side elementary school - in effect for 2026-27
- MacArthur's attendance boundary west of Packerland will be included in King Elementary attendance area
- Projections:
 - New school enrollment = approx. 547 students
 - Shift of approx. 86 students to King Elementary



Schedule

- **Preliminary Schedule (subject to change)**
 - Design through spring of 2025
 - Construction planned to begin spring/summer of 2025
 - Construction to be completed for start of the 2026 school year
