The No Idling Clean Air Initiative was implemented at the beginning of the school year with the support of Superintendent Lau and Superintendent Thompson. We are asking drivers to turn off their engines when waiting more than 10 seconds (weather permitting) while picking up children.

Pick-up and Drop-off Safety and Etiquette Guidelines:

- Enter at the North Michigan St entrance (Near Merrill St.) and pull ALL the way forward to the south end in a single file line, do not block the crosswalk
- Do not block the sidewalk or bus entrance when entering the parking lane, if it is full, pull past the entrance and use Michigan St for pick up, or go around the block until the area is clear
- NEVER park, stop or stand between Merrill and the pick-up lane entrance on Michigan St. this area is striped white and is posted no parking.
- Do NOT enter at the south entrance (Bolles/Michigan intersection)
- All cars should remain off of the playground area until the last bus loads students at 3:15 PM
- If you are at Foxview to pick up your child between 2:30 - 2:55 PM, use Michigan St. If you end up in the pick up line, do NOT leave your car. Instead, call the office and we will send your child to you.
- After you pick up your child, use the lane nearest the fence area to pull out and around remaining cars in the pick up line.
- When cars are leaving the pick up line please continue to pull forward to allow others to enter.
- Be cautious, aware of pedestrians, and PATIENT when using the pick up lane.
