POTENTIAL HEALTH IMPACT OF HEAVY BACKPACKS AND TAKE PROACTIVE MEASURES TO AVOID INJURY.

IMPORTANT POINTS TO REMEMBER REGARDING BACKPACK EDUCATION:

- BACKPACKS SHOULD WEIGH NO MORE THAN A MAXIMUM OF 10 PERCENT OF A CHILD'S BODY WEIGHT.
- 2. ERGONOMIC BACKPACKS WITH INDIVIDUALIZED COMPARTMENTS TO EFFICIENTLY HOLD BOOKS AND EOUIPMENT SHOULD BE ENCOURAGED.
- 3. CHILDREN SHOULD BE ENCOURAGED TO WEAR BOTH SHOULDER STRAPS AND NOT SLING THE BACKPACK OVER ONE SHOULDER.
- 4. BACKPACKS SHOULD HAVE WIDE, PADDED ADJUSTABLE STRAPS THAT FIT THE CHILD'S BODY.
