 - o 3 Documents as an overview of the curriculum
 - o PA Core Standards via "Standards Crosswalk by Illustrative Math"
 - Shows when the skills are taught and what skills are taught when and when your child should be able to have a skill mastered
 - You can use this document to see where your child stands on the standards and can adjust with supports and challenges, etc.
 - Includes Common Core Cluster, Common Core Standard (K-5) and PA Eligible Content (PSSAs) for grades 3-5
 - Has "big idea" learning clusters that are easy for parents and students to read
 - o Diagnostic Assessment Opportunities
 - Pre-Unit diagnostic assessment
 - Activities and centers
 - Cool downs
 - Practice problems
 - Section checkpoints
 - Dream Box (digital part of the curriculum found on Clever)
 - End of unit assessments
 - Summative Assessments
 - End of unit/chapter assessment (go down the chart vertically in the standards)
 - Will have a variety of types of questions
 - The assessments in this curriculum help prepare students for standardized testing and PSSAs, etc
 - Adaptations and Modifications Examples
 - This curriculum can be modified and adapted for your student
 - Speak with the teacher about this
 - Pacing and giving time on assessments, etc.
 - Use of manipulatives, visuals, etc.
