Consider including the following elements in your written Artist Statement:

- Explain the inspiration you found for your prepared piece or portfolio.
- What does it feel like when you're working in your art form?
- Explain the choices you made when creating your performance piece/portfolio. How did you create the mood, feeling, or message you want to convey?
- Why did you choose to include this piece in your performance or portfolio over other pieces you have designed?
