Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery Test

Are you interested in taking the ASVAB? The ASVAB (**Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery**) is a standardized test that measures a person's aptitude, strengths, and potential for military service. **THIS TEST IS NOT ONLY FOR STUDENTS INTERESTED IN JOINING THE MILITARY.** If your student IS interested in joining the military after they graduate, this test can help to **determine their eligibility for enlistment and job training in the military.** If your student is NOT interested in joining the military, the ASVAB can help them **understand their aptitudes, work-related interests, and work values.**

Student Check In/Out and Forgotten Item(s) Drop Off Procedures

Check-Out: Please ring the bell and wait to be greeted. Front office will ask for your student's name and to see your ID at the camera. Your student will be called, and they will meet you outside. Please be patient as there are often numerous students checking in or out at the same time as well as students and staff present in the office.

Student drivers must check out in the front office before leaving campus.

Check-In: Your student can come to the door, ring the bell and the front office will let them in. They will sign in at the office and get a pass for class. Parents are not required to walk their student into the building.

Forgotten Items: There is a cart outside of the front door where you can leave forgotten items, however we encourage students to take responsibility for their own things. The cart will be checked throughout the day and the items will be brought inside.
