In partnership with Alamo Colleges and industry professionals, our school will create industry and college pathways for students focused on in demand careers.

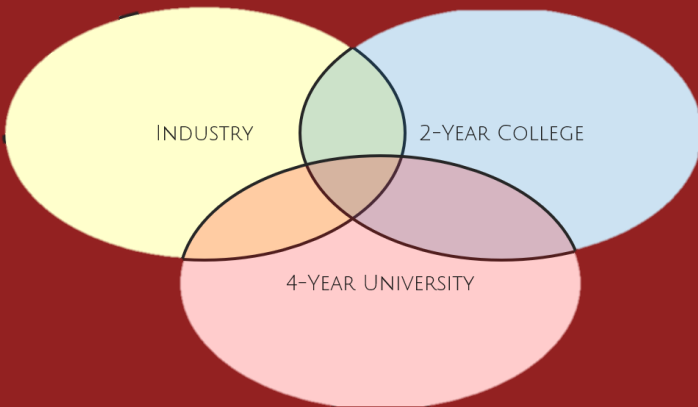
Vision

“The P-TECH 9-14 model addresses postsecondary degree completion and career readiness by smoothing the transitions between high school, college, and the professional world.”



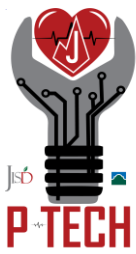
P-TECH:
