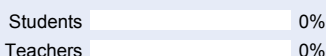

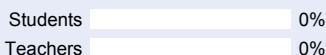

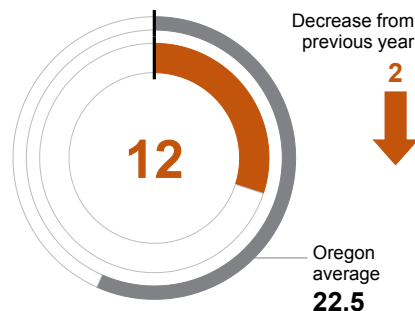

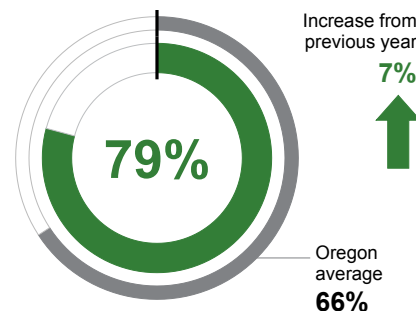
CLASS SIZE

REGULAR ATTENDERS

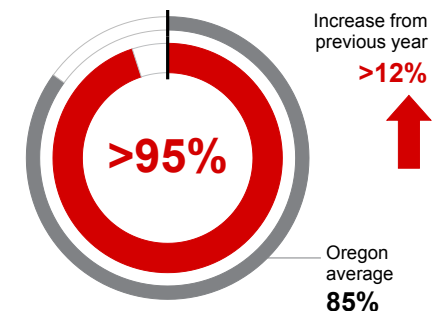
Students who attended more than 90% of their enrolled school days.

ON-TRACK TO GRADUATE

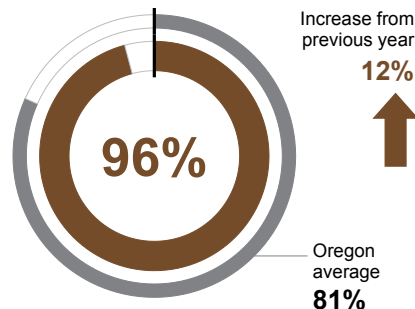
Students earning one-quarter of graduation credits in their 9th grade year.

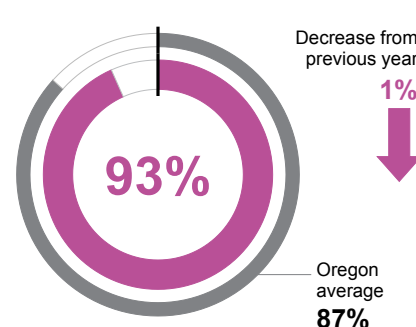
ON-TIME GRADUATION

Students earning a diploma within four years. Cohort includes students who were first-time ninth graders in 2019-20 graduating in 2022-23.



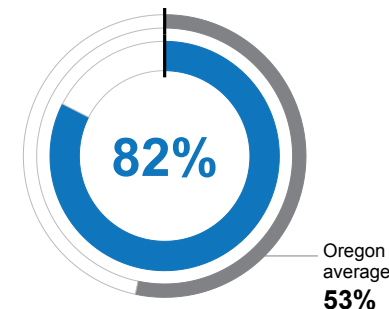
FIVE-YEAR COMPLETION

About Our School

ADVANCED COURSEWORK

RHS offers dual-enrollment courses with Western Oregon University & Portland State University. Students may take AP Exams. In 2024, 26 students took AP exams, and 83% of those scored a 3 or better on the exam. Students may engage in an Honors contract and earn Honors credit in every core class and most electives. Students are encouraged to complete a Riverdale diploma, requiring 4 more credits than the Oregon Diploma. Riverdale is currently in the candidacy phase for the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme.
