## Minutes

The meeting was called to order at 9:30 AM.

Rachael Freeman reviewed the confidentiality clause and the purpose of the Committee. Rachael led the committee in introductions and asked everyone to sign into the chat. The agenda, and confidentiality clause was reviewed.

Rachael explained that one of the main purposes of this Committee is to discuss findings from TEA Intruder Detection Audits, and that was the purpose of this special session. She advised that if there are additional findings, we will need to schedule additional meetings in a similar format.

Rachael reviewed what occurs when TEA shows up on a campus to conduct an IDA (Intruder Detection Audit). TEA will randomly select 3 doors to perform door checks on to make sure that the door is secured from the exterior. An unsecure door in this phase WILL result in a finding. TEA will then move on to inspect all other exterior doors to check for proper functionality. They will need an escort during this door check, and security can provide that escort. An unsecure door in this phase will not result in a finding, but will be documented. TEA will then ask for the door sweep logs, and campus safety plan, as well as check for HB3 compliance. Rachael advised that 38% of our campuses have received an IDA.

The Committee moved into closed session at 9:34 am and the confidentiality clause was reviewed again.

Adam Lewin reminded the Committee to sign in via the chat, and the Committee moved back into Open Session at 9:43 am.
