All Adventure Camp days are \$132 per child per week.
A multi-sibling discount is available for families.

Operating Hours

What to Bring

Campers are encouraged to bring a lunch, water bottle, sunscreen, and hat in a single backpack or bag that can be closed completely with a zipper, snap, or latch each day. Additionally, please wear closed-toed shoes for safety.

All items from home, including backpacks, should be clearly labeled with the camper's first and last name, please. We ask that all personal items, such as electronic devices, toys, etc. remain at home.

Snacks will be provided for each child each afternoon. In case of allergy or nutritional concerns, you can also bring snacks from home.

Registration

To register, a current DCPR Youth Activity Registration Packet must be on file prior to enrollment. These are available at the community center and online.
