SHAC COMMITTEE REPORTS:

EMPLOYEE WELLNESS AND EDUCATION:

The committee met on 10/14/2024 to review the current goals listed in the Wellness plan and had discussed recommendations. The committee will meet again before the next SHAC meeting to be ready to present an action plan. A copy of their report is attached to these minutes.

Several members of the SHAC committee did not have a copy of the WELLNESS Plan and Mr. Giamanco was asked to email that out to everyone.

NUTRITION, PHYSICAL AND HEALTH EDUCATION:

Jeanne Holloway stated that the committee had met and she had sent out a request for an update on the progress of the implementation of the current WELLNESS plan. She noted that many of the nutrition guidelines were state mandated.

Mr.Giamanco sent out an update today. It will be reviewed by the sub-committee.

STUDENT AND COMMUNITY HEALTH PROMOTION:

Casey is the chair of this sub-committee and to date there are no members.

COUNSELING AND SOCIAL EMOTIONAL WELLNESS:

Mr. Giamanco sent to the sub-committee a spreadsheet from each campus answering our request for an update on the progress of meeting the Wellness goals for counseling and social wellness. It will be reviewed by the sub-committee at the next meeting.

There was much discussion about the suggestion for a "Parent education night" to focus on why children are so stressed these days and parenting skills. Amy Bryan shared her expertise and past experiences with these kinds of evenings and the feedback from the committee was positive. The sub-committee will meet again to plan this event hopefully in the beginning of 2025.

Discussion followed about suicide prevention programs and the committee asked for an update on "Madi's Way" and when it was going to be implemented.

More specific information on programs being used for drug and alcohol prevention was requested. What material was used during Red Ribbon Week etc...

CATCH MY BREATH

Catch My Breath is being used in DAEP.

Copies of the program for High School and Middle School were available. This is an anti-vaping program. The committee decided they would like to see the program presented. Mr. Giamanco will contact Casey Rauschuber from Medical City Decatur and arrange a time for a presentation.

Brief discussion about a new security program called "SECURELY" being used by the district to identify possible at risk students based on words used while on school devices.
