Policy Statement

Hager Elementary recognizes that a child's education is a responsibility shared by the school and family during the entire period the child spends in school. To support the goal of the school to educate all students effectively, the school and parents must work as knowledgeable partners.

Although parents are diverse in culture, language, and needs, they share the school's commitment to the educational success of their children. Hager Elementary, within its boundaries, in collaboration with parents, shall establish programs and practices that enhance parent involvement and reflect the specific needs of students and their families.

To this end, the Hager faculty and staff support the development, implementation, and regular evaluation of parent involvement policy which will involve parents at all grade levels in a variety of roles. The Hager Elementary Parent Involvement policy will include, but not be limited to the following components:

- will be evaluated annually
- will provide timely information concerning the Title I program.
- will provide school performance profiles that show the school's progress toward meeting the learning goals and academic expectations (i.e. School Report Card and CSIP)
- will provide individual student assessment results and interpretation of those results
- will provide a description of the school curriculum
- will provide an opportunity for parent input to allow for suggestions and participation in decisions relating to the education of their children
- will provide a Hager School Compact that describes how the school, parents, and students will share the responsibility for improving student achievement
