

**Superintendent's PIE Meeting**

Superintendent Crozier opened the meeting at 11:01 a.m. and welcomed all who were present on Zoom.

Updates included:

- The Massachusetts School Building Authority has approved Sudbury's submission for accelerated roof repair projects at both Nixon and Haynes schools. This approval includes a reimbursement of 31% of the repair costs, with construction expected to begin in the summer of 2026.
- The Say Something program has successfully launched, with training completed for all grade levels. The District has already received several tips through the anonymous reporting system and has seen positive results so far.
- Budget Planning for FY26 is underway. Superintendent Crozier outlined the timeline and process, which includes meetings with building administrators and cost centers; Listening Sessions at each school, presentations during School Committee meetings, and discussions on budget priorities. The final budget recommendation will be presented to the School Committee for approval in late December.

Questions from participants included:

- Implementation of cell phone policies and yondr pouch storage.
- In regards to the Say Something Program, are all tips investigated, when and how are parents notified, reporting timeline and were age-appropriate reporting examples shared with students
- Updated the group on the status of remote access to School Committee meetings.
